
### **■** Problem Description:

# ■ Brief Solution - Step by Step:


#### Step1

Press **Del** to enter to the BIOS, and under **Advanced**, go to **IDE Configuration**.



#### Step2


Enable **Serial-ATA** (**SATA**), you should something like below. The mSATA is able to be recognized.



Save and reset.

## Step3

Go to Boot - Hard Drive BBS Priorities




And adjust to

Boot Option #1 will be your installation media, for example USB boot up disk. Boot Option #2 will be your mSATA.



# Step4

Press ESC and you should see something like this



Where your Boot Option #1 should be your installation media.
