■ **Problem Description & Architecture:**

This FAQ instructs user how to use https to access Dashboard2.0

■ **Brief Solution - Step by Step:**

Step1: open C:\Inetpub\wwwroot\broadweb\WADashboard\server.conf

Replace string {"server":{"port":443 as server:{port:10888

Replace string "tls":{"enable":false as "tls":{"enable":true

Step2: create a folder ex: D:\temp ,

copy C:\WebAccess\Node\cert\private\WaCert.pem to D:\temp ,

rename WaCert.pem as private.pem,

copy and replace private.pem to

C:\Inetpub\wwwroot\broadweb\WADashboard\example\ssl\private.pem

(note: backup original private.pem)

Step3: copy C:\WebAccess\Node\cert\certs\WaCert.pem to D:\temp ,

rename WaCert.pem as cert.pem,

copy and replace cert.pem to

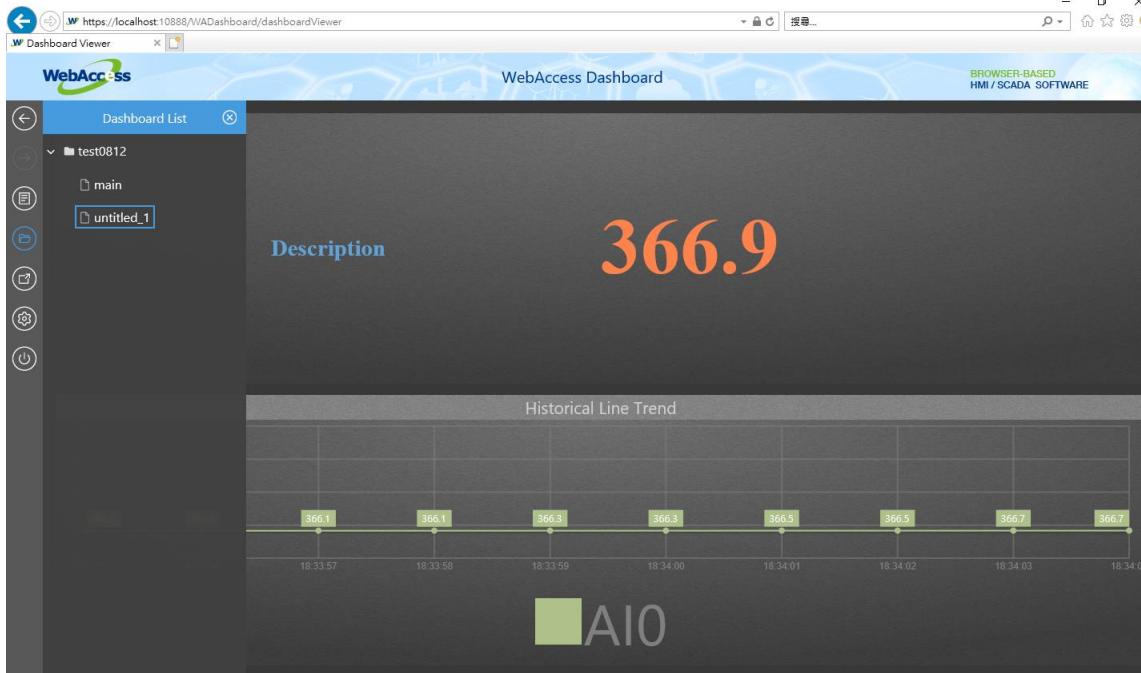
C:\Inetpub\wwwroot\broadweb\WADashboard\example\ssl\cert.pem

(note: backup original cert.pem)

Step4:use administrator to excute C:\Inetpub\wwwroot\broadweb\WADashboard\dashboard_stop.exe

use administrator to excute C:\Inetpub\wwwroot\broadweb\WADashboard\dashboard_start.exe

Step5: You will see IE use <https://localhost:10888/WADashboard/dashboardViewer> to access
