Abstract	ADAM-60XX and ADAM-62XX-The difference of JAVA function

■ Problem Description:

For ADAM-60XX-BE version, it support the HTML web-service function and the JAVA applets programing, can ADAM-60XX-CE and ADAM-62XX support it?

What's the difference of ADAM-60XX-BE, ADAM-60XX-CE and ADAM-62XX in terms of the web-service function?

■ Brief Solution - Step by Step:

Basically, two different java based languages (i.e. Java Applet and Java Script) are being used for running web browser application among ADAM-6000-BE, ADAM-6000-CE and 6200 series.

ADAM-6000-BE

As categorize from table above, the ADAM-6000-BE apply the older fashion "Java Applet" ONLY.

ADAM-6000-CE

After an later development of ADAM-6000-CE, it is able to support both Java Applet and Java Script(jQuery), BUT cannot be implement at the same time.

By default from manufacture process, Java Script(JQuery) with HTML5 default web-page is being adopted.

However, as what mentioned above, ADAM-6000-CE support both languages. So, you may import the Java Applet into ADAM-6000-CE from ADAM.Net utility if the requirement is to use Java Applet on ADAM-6000-CE.

ADAM-6200

ADAM-6200 only support Java Script(JQuery)
