## 4-port RS-232/422/485 PCI-104 Module

## Introduction

The PCM-3612I is a PCI-104-compatible 4-port RS-232/422/485 serial interface module. It works with PCI-104 CPU modules or CPU cards which accept PCI-104 expansion modules. It provides four independent serial interfaces, accessed through the IDE 40-pin connector(s). The module's industry-standard 16C550 asynchronous communication chip is fully programmable. The module requires no special commands or control codes if you use the standard COM1-COM4(PCM-3612I) port address

## **Initial Inspection**

We carefully inspected the PCM-3612I both mechanically and electrically before we shipped it. It should be free of marks and scratches and in perfect electrical order on receipt.

Handle the board only by its edges. The static charge on your body may damage its integrated circuits. Keep the card in its anti-static package whenever it is not installed. You can use this package to return the card if it should need repair.



#### Hardware Installation

Warning! Turn off PC whenever you install, remove connect or disconnect cables to PCM-3612I

#### Installing the Module on a CPU Card:


- 1. Turn the PC power off. Turn the power off to any peripheral devices such as printers and monitors.
- 2. Disconnect the power cord and any other cables from the back of the computer.
- 3. Remove the system unit cover
- 4. Remove the CPU card from the chassis (if necessary) to gain access to the card's PCI-104 connector.
- Screw the brass spacer (included with the module) into the threaded hole on the CPU card. Do not tighten too much, or the threads may be damaged.
- Carefully align the pins of the PCM-3612I with the PCI-104 connector. Slide the module into the connector, do not push too hard.
- 7. Secure the module to the CPU card to the threaded hole in the CPU card using the included screw.
- 8. Attach any accessories to the PCM-3612I.
- 9. Reinstall the CPU card and replace the system unit cover. Reconnect the cables you removed in step 2.
- 10. Turn the power on.

#### Connecting to Another PCI-104 Module:

- 1. Insert the pins of connector CN6 into the piggy-back connector on the other PCI-104 module.
- 2. Screw the PCM-3612I to the brass spacer. This completes the hardware installation
