There is a compatible issue of SanDisk Compact Flash card (Version ID: V2.01, which supports			
DMA mode) with PCM-5820. However, this problem is not seen in version ID: V1.01. If a user is			
using PCM-5820 with SanDisk Compact Flash card, system hangs when entering Operation			
System (Win CE & XPE) with DMA function enabled.

SOLUTION			
 In order to avoid this kind of problem happening again. It is necessary to use the software named "NAND Athens DMA ON/OFF Utility Version 1.4" (please see the attached zip file) to disable DMA function of SanDisk Compact Flash card. 			
 2. Detailed procedures are as follows. A. Extract the zip file to the target Compact Flash card. B. Execute "dmaonoff /s /d" and press enter. (/s: select Secondary IO Mode; /d: disable Athens DMA.
