



# KNOWN PROBLEM REPORT

<b>PROBLEM DESCRIPTION</b>			
<p>There is a compatible issue of SanDisk Compact Flash card (Version ID: V2.01, which supports DMA mode) with PCM-5820. However, this problem is not seen in version ID: V1.01. If a user is using PCM-5820 with SanDisk Compact Flash card, system hangs when entering Operation System (Win CE &amp; XPE) with DMA function enabled.</p>			
			
<b>SOLUTION</b>			
<p>1. In order to avoid this kind of problem happening again. It is necessary to use the software named "NAND Athens DMA ON/OFF Utility Version 1.4" (please see the attached zip file) to <a href="#">disable DMA function</a> of SanDisk Compact Flash card.</p> <p>2. Detailed procedures are as follows.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>A. Extract the zip file to the target Compact Flash card.</li><li>B. Execute "dmaonoff /s /d" and press enter. (/s: select Secondary IO Mode; /d: disable Athens DMA. More information please refer "dmaonoff /?" to understand.)</li><li>C. The "PASS" can be seen and that means DMA function has been disabled.</li></ul>
