### **■** Problem Description:


When display tag values in View and ViewDAQ, user requests to have certain number of zero in front of tag values. Example, when tag value is 12.3, he prefers to read 00012.3 in View and ViewDAQ.

## **■** Brief Solution - Step by Step:

Solution 1: always fix number of 0 in front:


You may try to use "format" function to add zero in front.

But you also need to figure out how to control number of zero in front of the string.

#### Solution 2: number of zero is based on current value





Enabling an Intelligent Planet

set x [string range 0000000[GETVAL A0] end-8 end] SETVAL myText=[format "%s" \$x]

Note: 8 indicates total number of characters

Note1: 0000000 can't ignore.
