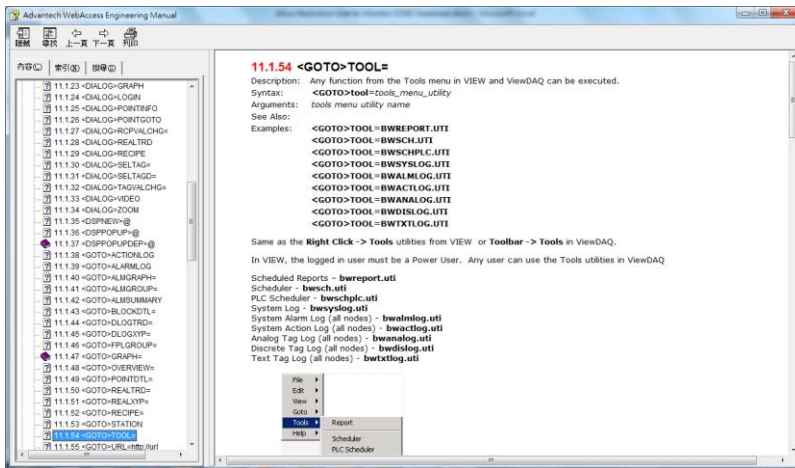

■ Problem Description:

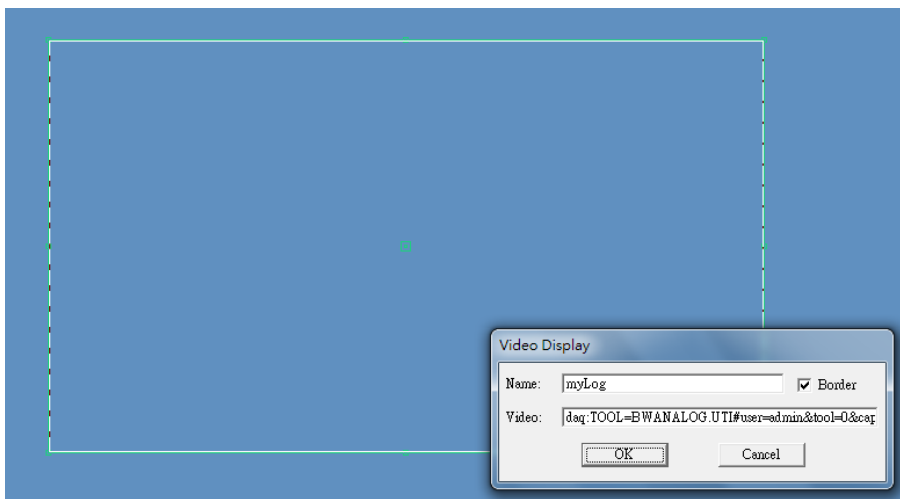
Restrict User has no rights to monitor ODBC data log (such as Analog Log). What can we do if we prefer restrict user to monitor ODBC data log.

■ Brief Solution - Step by Step:

1. This document describes how to add ODBC UIT to bgr page, then allow Restriction User rights to monitor this bgr page
2. Based on User Manual 11.1.54, each log has its own uti
Ex. Analog Tag Log uti is bwalog.uti



3. Insert bwalog.uti to Video Display
daq:TOOL=BWALOG.UTI#user=admin&tool=0&capt=0&stat=0



Save this page as a.bgr

4. Add a Restrict User, then click “Advanced (Restricted User)...” button
